Seashore fishing is a fun, family-friendly way to enjoy nature while discovering the sea's hidden treasures. At low tide, set off along the beach in search of shellfish, tiny crabs and other marine wonders. This hands-on activity suitable for all ages, combines fun, discovery and respect for the marine environment.

Grab a bucket and a net and head off for a one-of-akind seaside adventure. Just remember to respect minimum catch sizes and help preserve the fragile coastal ecosystem so everyone can keep enjoying it.

OUR HINTS

Before heading out

- Check the fishing sanitary conditions
- of the fishing areas.
- Check the tide times and coefficients.

A minimum coefficient of 80 is required and you must be on site 1.5 hours before low tide.

 Check the weather forecast and inform someone of your expected return time, especially if you are going alone.

While fishing

 Respect fishing and consumption restrictions.
 Respect sizes, quantities, and seasonality.

Remember to get a measuring stick, which is available from the Tourist Office.

- Watch the tide and come back 45 minutes after low tide to avoid getting caught out.
- Only catch what you can eat; do not overfish.
- Do not touch professional equipment.



TIDES

Tides, while essential to the natural balance of ecosystems, can be particularly dangerous, especially if you're not familiar with their dynamics. Walkers and swimmers can easily become trapped on sandbanks due to the rapid rise and fall of the tide, known as ebb and flow. Even experienced swimmers can be swept away by tidal currents, which can be powerful and unpredictable.

Additionally, tides vary depending on the region and the phase of the moon, making some beaches more prone to exceptionally high or low tides. It is essential that you check tide schedules and remain alert to rapid changes in the coastal environment.

OUR WALKING TRAILS

DOMAINE DU ROHART

natural site within the commune of Camiers. Domaine du Rohart the spreads over a dozen hectares. Located north of Baie de Canche, it is nestled in the heart of a complex of exceptional natural spaces. The landscape is a mixture of forest habitats and reed beds that are home to remarkably diverse biotopes containing over 180 species. The Rohart plant estate has a one-kilometrelong wooden board walk and is located close to the Sainte Cécile dune trail

THE DUNES TRAIL

The Sainte Cécile dunes are open for walks. A circuit is accessible either via the northern end of the Boulevard de Lille, or via the Boulevard de Sainte Cécile, level with the Avenue des Courlis.

THE NATIONAL NATURAL RESERVE OF THE BAIE DE CANCHE

Classified National as а Nature Reserve in 1987, the Baie de Canche is home to an exceptional diversity of animals and plants. The panoramic vista from the highest point of the site offers breathtaking views over hundreds of hectares of wilderness. It is home to a multitude of landscapes and the undulating landscape of dunes, pools and channels all change in line with the seasons and the tides.

The reserve is accessible from Camiers, or Étaplessur-mer. Dogs are not allowed.

HISTORICAL HERITAGE



LARGE-SCALE EXHIBITION ABOUT WORLD WAR I

Permanent exhibition Place of Remembrance Rue John Mc Crae 62176 CAMIERS

Like many of the villages on the home front of the Opal Coast, Camiers was deeply affected by the First World War.

From spring 1915 onwards, men and women serving in the army from the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth countries (Australia, Canada, South Africa, etc.) began to settle in the area, initially in the British camp at Étaples, and then at Camiers. The village not only became the base for the Machine Gun Corps (machine gun training camps) but also the site for British, Canadian and American military hospitals.

After the war, the English camp

ARMAND LIGHT-

Previously standing in the dunes of Camiers at the eastern end of the right bank of the Canche estuary? It was named in honour of its first keeper, François Ramet, nicknamed Père Armand. The Armand Lighthouse is a veritable maritime symbol the entrance markina de Canche. to the Baie



barracks were used to house many children, before being transformed into buildings. The opening of a sanatorium in 1933 and the creation of the Albert Calmette Institute is a reminder of the continuing relevance of the hospital sector in Camiers.



SAINT FÉLICIEN CHAPEL IN SAINTE CÉCILE

Saint Félicien Chapel Rue des Lys| 62176 SAINTE CÉCIL

Welcome to the Saint Félicien Chapel! Built in 1964, and later expanded by architect Marc Lenouvel, it was embellished by artist Fleur Nabert in 2024. The general idea was to draw inspiration from the beauty of the Côte d'Opale to create a sensory experience that leads to introspection.

Architect Marc Lenouvel designed the plans for this contemporary renovation, and the interior was beautifully decorated by sculptor Fleur Nabert. The entrance to the chapel is adorned with translucent stained glass windows depicting symbols of faith, hope, and charity, evocative of the nearby sea. The stained glass windows, created by Atelier Loire in Chartres, create a gradient of light that leads to the choir.

The chapel can accommodate up to 150 people and is characterised by a long-pitched roof and coated concrete walls. It also features by a large wooden cross and a metal bell holder.

The chapel combines modernity and spirituality, offering visitors a unique and contemplative experience.

NOTRE DAME DE LA MER CHURCH IN CAMIERS

Église Notre Dame de la Mer Rue de l'Église | 62176 CAMIERS

The church of Notre Dame de la Mer was built on the eve of World War I. It is built predominantly from Baincthun stone, which gives the exterior walls of the church a special character. Its somewhat stocky porch opens out under an elegant bell tower. The decorative elements were carefully observed and the mosaics on the outside, above the porch, are similar to those found in Amiens Cathedral.

As soon as visitors enter the church, their eves are drawn to the high altar; it is an imposing work of art that depicts the Virgin Mary controlling the waves. Accordina to master alassmakers Rolland and Dewidehem, the church had the most beautiful stained alass windows in the region before the war And these renovated stained alass windows are the highlight of any visit to Notre Dame Church, which is open every school holiday on Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and from June to September on Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. At the top of the 40-metre bell tower, you can also see the new
